ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

- The Contract of Enrollment is due on May 15, 2018. Tuition will be billed through FACTS.
- Three options are available for tuition payments:
 - Monthly checking/savings account ACH electronic draft**
Tuition is divided into an 12-month interest-free payment plan with the first payment drafted June 16, 2018, and the final payment drafted May 16, 2019.
 - One time pay in full ACH electronic draft**
100% of tuition paid online on or before June 2, 2018. \$100 discount per student in Educational Therapy; \$50 discount per student in Search & Teach or RX for Reading (*Discount is forfeited if the payment is late.*)
 - Two payments ACH electronic draft**
50% of tuition paid online on or before June 2, 2018 and December 2, 2018. \$35 discount per payment, per student in Educational Therapy only. (*Discount is forfeited if the payment is late.*)
- Under the monthly payment plan, an account wherein sufficient funds are not available will assess a \$15 fee per occurrence. The family will be notified; and if complete payment has not been made within five days of the notification, a \$25 late fee will be charged to the family's CHA account.
- If any part of the tuition becomes more than 30 days overdue, the student may not be admitted to Discovery until satisfactory arrangements are made with the Director of Business. Additionally, tuition accounts must be current at the end of the first semester for the student to attend sessions the second semester. If there are times of financial difficulty, please contact the Director of Business to discuss arrangements.
- A condition of enrollment for all students is that the PARENT/GUARDIAN understands that they must carefully examine, agree with, and sign the Discovery Parental Agreement.
