



Christian Heritage Academy Basketball Safety Protocols

Welcome to our facilities here at Christian Heritage Academy. Given the current state of COVID-19, it is our desire to create an environment that is conducive to slowing down the spread of the virus and encourage good health and safety practices for all who enter our facility. We also have limitations in place to help us accomplish this and limit exposure. We appreciate your help with the following limitations and guidelines when you are at our facilities.

**** The OSSAA in conjunction with the Governor's Office and the State Department of Health established the maximum capacity at 50% for each facility during all sessions of the play-offs - 400*

The following minimum mandates will be implemented at each play-off site. School administration is responsible for compliance with all mandates:

1. Facial coverings/masks will be required for all coaches, spectators and any participants not actively involved in the contest.
2. Social distancing practices will be observed.
3. Facilities will be cleaned between contests/sessions unless the same two schools are participating in the next contest.
4. Seating will be designated to meet the 50% capacity mandate.

Clearing the facility between contests: The facility will be cleared between contests of a two-game session unless the same two schools are involved in the session. (The second game participants in the session come from the same schools as the first game participants)

Seating:

- We will not allow seating on the first row of bleachers closest to the floor.
- Seating will be limited to every other row.
- Non-seating rows will be clearly marked.

Masks:

- Players, and officials will not be required to wear masks on the court.
- For non-participants, **masks will be required at all times** during the games unless eating or taking a drink. Please, do not lengthen your eating time to circumvent the rule.
- Announcements will be made over the PA system if it is noticed masks are not being worn.
- If individuals continue to not wear masks, then they will be kindly asked to exit the facility.

Locker rooms:

- Locker rooms will be available for use by visiting teams. The visiting school can determine whether to use those facilities or not. Locker rooms will be cleaned prior to the visiting team use of the locker room.

Ball Sanitizing:

- Balls will be sanitized prior to each game.
- We will also sanitize and rotate during all games.

Cheer:

- Each school is limited to 10 spirit squad members. All squad members are required to wear a mask.

Sportsmanship:

- We believe good sportsmanship is vital in athletic competition. But, given the current state of covid-19, both teams will either walk by and give verbal congratulatory remarks or wave towards the other team.



Christian Heritage Academy Playoff Ticket Information

All spectators must wear a mask and be able to answer “No” to the COVID screening questions in order to enter the gym. Spectators will be expected to follow the OSSAA Basketball Safety Protocols

GAME TIMES: All game times are set by OSSAA. There will be two sessions:

Afternoon session games at 1 p.m. and 3 p.m.

Evening session games at 6 p.m. and 8 p.m.

Please enter through the EAST ENTRANCE.

*If the facility needs to be cleared between contest we will exit through the WEST EXIT.

TICKET SALES & PRICES:

- Tickets will be \$7 per session and will be sold at the site. Anyone school age or above will be required to purchase a ticket. If the facility is cleared within a session a ticket stub must be presented to re-enter the second game of a session. Sites may use a stamp in place of a ticket stub.
- Gate opens one hour before each session.
- Must be present to purchase tickets. No prepurchase for groups.

OSSAA PASSES

- OSSAA - For 2020-2021 playoff contest. VALID ONLY when visibly presented with driver's license. NOT VALID FOR STUDENTS GRADES K-12. This pass ONLY ADMITS the CARDHOLDER
